Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

16<sup>th</sup> June Psalter Week 3 - Year C

### First Reading: 2 Samuel 12:7-10, 13

Nathan, who earlier brought the word of promise, now announces Yahweh's judgment of King David's sins of adultery and murder. Today's passage from Samuel 2 begins just after Nathan speaks a parable of the poor man's lamb being taken by another and through it affords David an opportunity to recognize and humbly repent for his sins.

### Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 31

*Forgive Lord the guilt of my sin -*

### Second Reading: Galatians 2:16, 19-21

The letter to the Galatians is Paul's most impassioned written work. He is upset that the Galatians have so quickly abandoned his teaching for what he describes as "another gospel". However, his main concern is about those who advocate continuing to observe the Jewish Law in addition to their faith in Christ.

### Gospel: Luke 7: 36-8:3

The Lord's attitude to the woman who was a sinner stands in stark contrast to the way she was judged by those who accompanied Jesus. He readily detects, and accepts, the love that drives her to publicly anoint his feet and wipe them with her hair – despite the obvious horror felt by some of those who witnessed the event, not least among them Simon, Jesus' host. From the woman's perspective, Jesus was gentle and loving in his approach. He understood that rejection and judgment never help to change a person.
