Psalter Week 1 - Year C 17<sup>th</sup> March 2013

### First Reading: Isaiah 43:16-21

This reading, from Second Isaiah, recalls the Exodus, where the Israelites received their freedom through the sea. Yet they should not live on past glories. We are reminded of the ministry of John the Baptist when we hear of a path in the wilderness. Those of us reading the same text today in Ireland think of Patrick and how we keep his flame burning by singing the praises of the Lord.

### Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 125 What marvels the Lord worked for us! Indeed we were glad -

### Second Reading: Ephesians 1:3-6, 11-12

Paul has reached a zenith – a point at which he is comfortable, having emptied himself of all desire for self-gain and placing himself totally in the hands of Christ. He is not however naïve, he does not think that the way forward is all sweetness and light. Taking a metaphor from the world of athletics, he realizes that he has to run the hard yards, with the assurance that Christ runs with him.

### Gospel: Luke 1:26-38

At the beginning of this Gospel, Jesus takes the classic pose of a master, seated with the disciples around him. The scribes and Pharisees set a trap, will Jesus uphold the letter of the Law, the word of God passed down to Moses? Scholars have speculated for years on what Jesus may have written in the sand, yet this something we will never know. The focus of the passage is on the compassion

of Jesus.
