> Twenty Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time 6th October Psalter Week 3 - Year C

First Reading: Habakkuk 1:2-3, 2-4

Habakkuk cries to God. He cries for justice. It seems as if God is not listening and not helping. Habakkuk is beginning to despair, until he realizes that justice will be a reality, when we cry loud enough. Justice is coming at the right time. The answer given to Habakkuk shows, deeds are not as important as persistence.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 94 O that today you would listen to his voice! Harden not your hearts -

Second Reading: 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14

The Second Letter to Timothy is an encouragement to the leaders of the communities who are following the apostle Paul – at the time a prisoner – reminds Timothy of the gift of the Holy Spirit, the one who is providing his power, love and self-control to the ones who are committed to proclaiming the Gospel.

Gospel: Luke 17: 5-10

The Gospel of this Sunday is divided into three parts: The apostles' question, the answer of Jesus and the parable of the servant. The question is the key for our understanding of this Gospel passage. The apostles ask Jesus to increase their faith. With the comparison with the mustard seed, Jesus is showing his disciples, that a small but true faith has an immense power.
