Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

9th June Psalter Week 2 - Year C

First Reading: 1 Kings 17: 17-24

In this very moving and dramatic passage from 1 Kings we hear of how a young boy in the house where the prophet Elijah is staying becomes seriously ill. Understandably, the child's mother wonders if her guest, this "man of God", is in fact the cause of her son's condition. Elijah takes the child, pleads with God to revive him and returns him to his mother safe and well.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 29

I will praise you Lord, you have rescued me -

Second Reading: Galatians 1:11-19

Paul is eager to demonstrate that he is not a spokesperson for any of the apostles, and that he was not influenced by anyone, other than Jesus himself, prior to, during or after his powerful encounter with the Lord on the road to Damascus. Therefore, when he dispenses from traditional legal observances, he does so based on his conviction that this is an integral part of the Gospel.

Gospel: Luke 7: 11-17

In the era of dedicated news channels, the sight of funeral processions with the bodies of young people killed as a result of war or famine is not unusual. All too often, too, are the reports of young people killed in motoring accidents. No matter what the circumstances, there is always a grieving family, The one response capable of helping is the one adopted by Jesus in our gospel: compassion.

An Invitation from Bishop Treanor.

Ever since taking up my appointment as your Bishop in 2008 I have been keen to work with you to establish a united vision for the Diocese. A vision that would enable each of us in the Diocese of Down and Connor through the use of our individual gifts to participate in our Church Community, to deepen our faith and to share that faith with others.

Your enthusiastic support for the Listening process gave me a sense of great hope and the themes which emerged from the process have over the past few months been considered by Working Groups in the Diocese comprised of your fellow Laity, Clergy and Religious. The fruits of their efforts have resulted in a Pastoral Plan which will be launched in the Waterfront on Fri. 27th & Sat. 28th September

I earnestly hope that Parishioners from every Parish in the Diocese will attend the Congress as Delegates. The event presents a real opportunity for all of us in the Diocese to strike out on a new path and to renew our commitment.

The cost for each Delegate is £10 which will be used to offset the costs associated with the venue. Each Delegate will be able to attend on both the Friday and Saturday and will be able to attend two Seminars addressing the key elements of the pastoral plan on the Saturday. If you wish to indicate your availability to represent your Parish as a delegate please contact your Parish Priest.

To close the Congress there will be a celebratory concert in the evening of the Saturday featuring a wide range of talent from the diocese including *The Priests*. Tickets for the Concert will be available at a cost of £20. Please let your Parish Priest know if you would like to attend.
