> Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time 23rd June Psalter Week 4 - Year C

First Reading: Zechariah 12:10-11, 13:1

Zechariah emphasizes God's abiding love for his people and for the land of Israel. God's love is a mature love that commits him to defend and bless his people if only they will renew their love and commitment to him. Today's passage looks forward to a time when a new spirit will be poured out on the people and they will mourn over the one they put to death.

> Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 62 For you my soul is thirsting, O God, my God -

> > Second Reading: Galatians 3:26-29

For Paul, the purpose of the Law was simply to be the people's guardian until the time when God's promise to send the Messiah was fulfilled and until the people could be justified by faith in the Christ. In today's text Paul teaches that for those who are baptized there must be no more distinctions. Because of Christ all have equal access to the blessings promised to Abraham.

Gospel: Luke 9:18-24

It is a feature of each of the Gospels that Peter's confession of faith in Jesus is always followed by a prediction of the passion. In today's passage from Luke, Peter's confession comes while Jesus is praying alone in the presence of some of his disciples. Peter speaks up confidently and courageously acknowledges Jesus as God's Anointed One.
