Proceeds from Cake Sale Update

In February of this year we held a very successful cake sale which raised a fantastic £610 and we would like to give an update on how the funds are being spent. So far, we have purchased and distributed 300 small Holy Water bottles (£84), purchase 300 Order of Mass cards (£150) and donated £100 towards new books and an El Salvador Cross for the Children's Liturgy. This leaves a balance of £276 which, along with two donations from Parishioners, covers the cost of the two Holy water fonts positioned in the side porches. This was all made possible by the enthusiastic support of our Parishioner and we are most grateful.

Over the summer, we plan to install additional shelving and work surfaces in the porch kitchen and will we will be fund raising for this in the autumn.

Pentecost Sunday 8th June 2014 Year A Psalter Week 4

First Reading: Acts: 2:1-11

Following the Ascension, the disciples waited. Fearful and lonely, they clung to the last promise that Jesus had made to them; baptism with the Holy Spirit. The day of Pentecost changed everything. These simple men from Galilee charged out into the streets of Jerusalem, the very city had turned against them, and proclaimed the glorious deeds and power of God. For the first time, these men had the courage of their convictions.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 103 Send forth your Spirit, O Lord, and renew the face of the earth -

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13

We often tend to think of our Christian mission as "one size fits all". We imagine that there is only one way to serve God, one lifestyle that will please him and one role that surpasses all others. In this letter, St Paul explains the many gifts of the Spirit. A community cannot work if every person attempts to fulfill the same role.

Gospel: John 20:19-23

All of Jesus' appearances after his resurrection follow a similar pattern. His disciples are hurt, broken, fearful and confused. They do not recognize Jesus. He does something distinctive that sparks recognition, in this case, showing them the wounds in his hands and side. They are filled with joy and faith. Finally, Jesus gives them a gift. He gives his disciples the Holy Spirit, the divine breath of life, the spark that animates them with faith to understand the Good News.
