Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time 26th October 2014 Year A Psalter Week 2

First Reading: Ezekiel 22:20-28

This reading comes from what is known as the covenant code that lays down the conditions for Israel and reveals the humane nature of the Israelite law code. It advocates being especially attentive to those within the community who are most vulnerable, defenceless or disadvantaged – the foreigner, the widow, the orphan, the poor. For Israel's God is a God who cares for the poor.

Responsorial Psalm: 17 I love you, Lord, my strength -

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10

Paul recalls the route taken by the early missionaries. The Good News was effectively spread by the witness of a Christian lifestyle. This process began with Paul himself and his companions. It had such an extraordinary effect that countless people converted from paganism and in tur made a comparable impact on the lives of others. The Christian message is contagious!

Gospel: Matthew 22:34-40

The Gospel reminds us that the only proper response to a loving and compassionate God is to love him with all our heart and our neighbor as ourselves. This in a nutshell is what Christianity is all about. That is why there is something askew about the lives of those who claim to love God, but care nothing about their neighbor or those who exhaust themselves working for a better world but never think of God or pray to him.
