Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time
28th September 2014 Year A Psalter Week 2

First Reading: Ezekiel 18:25-28
A sinner's conversion means so much to God that he forgets all the sin that has gone before and showers the convert with mercy and life. This may seem unfair to those who count on their own self-righteousness. In their desire for justice (a justice on their terms), they have forgotten mercy and have alienated themselves from God who is love. Love demands a total gift of self and not a calculating reliance on our own righteousness.

Responsorial Psalm: 24
Remember your mercy, Lord -

Second Reading: Phillippians 2:1-11
Paul appeals to our life in Christ, to the Spirit we have in common, to love, tenderness and sympathy in urging the community to be united in love. He gets to the core of what being a Christian is so as to encourage us to live as Christian's. Humility is the key to putting others first. And in Jesus we have the perfect example, who "was humbler yet, even to accepting death, death on a cross".

Gospel: Matthew 21:28:32
In Jesus' parable the vineyard can again be seen to represent Israel or the Church. All are called to work in it. Yet, it is not what we say that counts but what we do. Sometimes, by our words, we can convince ourselves that we are doing the Lord's work, when in fact we have not even entered the vineyard. Our self-righteousness and pride blinds us to the task.

Produced by the internationally renowned Radharc Films Company, and screened on RTE when transmissions were not available in the North of Ireland, these special showings offer audiences first time opportunities to see truly inspirational films made to bring reports from around the world on the theme of the Christian gospels understood in their widest sense.

Thus the subjects included human rights, faith, religion, injustices, Irish Christian heritage and struggles against persecution. In total some 400 thirty minutes films were transmitted from the 60's to the 90's, bringing wide-spread acclaim to the production teams headed by two young Dublin priests sent to the USA to learn the skills of modern day film production. And indeed the background to the making of these films is a story for another occasion.

So join us in the Parish Centre for the showings of the first two films brought to you by the Parish Pastoral Council. Admission is free, tea and coffee will be served, and if you wish, a small donation to help cover the cost of buying the films would be very welcome.
