First Reading: Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17

Ezekiel refers to the Lord as both Judge and Shepherd. The Lord will judge between good and evil, right and wrong but only after he has tried to lead them to good pastures, bandaging their wounds and rescuing the stray. He will be fair to them all, looking after the needy and the strong as the true shepherd should do.
