Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed 2nd November 2014 Year A Psalter Week 3

First Reading: Isaiah 25: 6-9

This reading has apocalyptic overtones. The language depicts God as being in control, and that it is YHWH who saves. It speaks of a banquet for all peoples. It is God who will put an end to death and wipe away the tears from every cheek, with consolation for all nations. Therefore, this imagery displays a powerful language in which Israel's experience of oppression under foreign rule is removed.

Responsorial Psalm: 26
The Lord is my light and my help -

Second Reading: Romans 5: 5-11

Christ crucified reconciles us to God though we are sinners. The cross before human eyes was perceived as an act of scandal. In this act of "scandal", Paul boasts that God shows his love for us. On account of this love, Paul trusts in God. It is through God's power, the cross became the instrument of hope, leading us to the life of the resurrection of our Lord.

Gospel: Matthew 11: 25-30

In his thanksgiving prayer to God, Jesus addresses God as "Father, Lord of heaven and earth". The defining relationship of the Gospel of Matthew is God as Father to his Son, Jesus extends this relationship to his followers by teaching them to address God as father in prayer (Our Father). Today's Gospel reading once again shows, how Jesus invites those to whom he chooses to reveal the Father into his relationship with the Father.
