I assume that everyone wants to be happy. We do come across people who appear to enjoy making everybody else's life miserable. It would be great if we could be happy at all times. Maybe we should be. If we look close enough most of the time we can really see somebody who has a cause to be unhappy. That does not stop us from feeling sorry for ourselves.

Gospel: John 1:6-8,19-28

We have more from John the Baptist today. Being Advent that is no surprise to us. This week the men from Jerusalem want to know what he is, in essence they want to know which category he fits into. We like to do that too because then we know where we stand. Maybe the Pharisees were able to put John in a category on the basis of his answer to them. Categorising people can allow us to see who is for us and who is against us.
