# The Baptism of the Lord 11<sup>th</sup> January 2015 Year B Psalter 1

#### First Reading: Isaiah 55:1-11

In biblical times, kings often celebrated the inauguration of their reign by providing a great banquet for their people. Isaiah uses this metaphor to describe how God, the divine king, provides a rich banquet to invite Israel into relationship. The people of Israel should turn to God "while he may be found -while he is near"

## Responsorial Psalm: 12 With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation –

### Second Reading: 1 John 5:1-9

The life of faith is like a life within a family. God is the parent in this family; believers are brothers and sisters. As in any healthy family, the bonds strengthen through observance of family parameters – here God's commandments which "are not burdensome". The references to water point to the baptism that revealed Jesus as the Christ and Son of God at the beginning of his earthly ministry.

## Gospel: Mark 1:7-11

The readings of the Christmas season offer a progression in the story of the manifestation of Jesus as the Chosen One of God. Mark's real concern in this passage is Jesus' identity. The signs that accompany his baptism acknowledge Jesus as the Son of God.
