Second Sunday in Ordinary Time 18th January 2015 Year B Psalter 2

First Reading: 1 Samuel 3:3-10, 19

This is the first of two "call and response" stories in today's readings. The Lord calls the boy Samuel and, once he understands this call, his response is total: "here I am". But the Lord has to call Samuel three times before the penny drops, and even then it is Eli who figures out what is happening and best the boy should respond. Without Eli's help Samuel does not understand the call.

Responsorial Psalm: 39 Here I am Lord! I come to do your will -

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 6:13-15, 17-20

This reading reminds us of our value as persons, that we are greatly loved by God. We reverence God with our minds and bodies and by our choices and behaviours. The Spirit of God moves within and between us. The people of Corinth have heard the gospel message and struggle to remain faithful to it. Remaining faithful is not always easy!

Gospel: John 1:35-42

In the third Scripture reading today we hear another story of call and response. Here the invitation to discipleship is aided and abetted by those close to Jesus. John does not hesitate to direct his own disciples towards Jesus. Then Jesus takes the initative and invites them into his company. He asks them "What are you looking for?" Jesus asks each of us the same question!
