# Fourth Sunday of Lent 15<sup>th</sup> March 2015 Year B Psalter 4

#### **First Reading: 2 Chronicles 36:14-16, 19-23**

In this reading we have a theological reflection on the history of Israel. The writer is able to see the hand of God in the events that have shaped his people. Are we able to see the hand of God at work in recent history?

Responsorial Psalm: 136
O let my tongue cleave to my mouth if I remember you not --

#### **Second Reading: Romans Ephesians 2:4-10**

Artists can be very precious about their work; and rightly so. They have poured their heart and soul in their work. Even though they may sell or produce are for someone else, it is still somehow always theirs. We are God's work of art. He has poured his very life into us. We are his. The work forever bears the signature of the creator no matter how badly the world treats it.

## **Gospel: John 3:14-21**

In the opening lines of the Gospel we have a trans-valuation of values. That which is deadly (the serpent) became a symbol of healing (Moses' bronze work). Lifestyles that were once considered deviant or immoral are now normalized. Is trans-valuation a good or a bad thing? It can be either, or. A traditional symbol that is place out of context can shock us into thinking. Nicodemus would have been shocked by what Jesus was saying. But he needed to be shocked out of his comfort zone in order to experience the grace of God.
