Second Sunday of Easter Divine Mercy Sunday 12th April 2015 Year B Psalter 2

First Reading: Acts 4:32-55

In this reading from Acts, we are given a glimpse of what life was like in the early Christian community. Power was gained from their testimony of the resurrection of Jesus. What is striking is the sense of solidarity and community which emerges from the passage. From each according to his ability, to each according to his need; all ego was set aside as the group focused on preaching the gospel.

Responsorial Psalm: 117
Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, for his love has no end -

Second Reading: 1 John 5:1-6

John speaks about being a witness to God who is "love" and "life eternal" is promised to those who live a life of loving God. God is now our dwelling place, our home. Each one of us is God's child, sister or brother to the Son when we confess Jesus is the Christ, God's anointed One.

Gospel: John 20:19-31

At the end of last week's Gospel, Peter and John, having "seen and believed", left the empty tomb and went back to their homes. It seems that the disciples were not immediately energized by the resurrection, rather they hid away in fear. Even those who had lived with Jesus for the three years of his earthly ministry needed something extra. Jesus appears to them unencumbered by locked doors, and offers them gifts of peace and the Spirit. Armed with the Spirit they can confidently go forward and spread the good news.
