Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 12th July 2015 Year B Psalter 3

First Reading: Amos 7:12-15

Amos, it seems, is a reluctant prophet, more comfortable in his role as shepherd and tender of sycamore trees than preaching to the priest of Bethel. Yet he recognizes too that he is chosen by God to go and 'prophesy to my people Israel.' Recognising that God has chosen us for some purpose, despite our reluctance, might be worth reflecting on.

Responsorial Psalm 84:

Let us see, O Lord, your mercy and give us your saving help -

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:3-14

Paul begins his letter to the Ephesians with a profound reflection on the fact that the Father has chosen us in Christ and filled us with every grace and blessing so that we can play our part in his purpose and plan. Paul's reflection invites a response from each one of us for God's choice of us and his goodness to us.

Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

Jesus' chosen ones, the Twelve, are sent out in pairs on a mission – to preach repentance. Their reaction is not recorded. Did they go with enthusiasm or reluctance? In whatever situation we are in, we are chosen and commissioned to continue Jesus' work in the world. How committed are we to our commission.
