# Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time 16<sup>th</sup> August 2015 Year B Psalter 4

First Reading: Proverbs 9:1-6

Wisdom is here introduced as a magnificent queen, very great and very generous. The Word of God is this wisdom in which He makes known his goodwill to men; God the Word is this Wisdom, to whom the Father has committed all judgement. Wisdom calls on the foolish to leave behind their ways and walk on the road to perception – the path of truth.

Responsorial Psalm 33-Taste and see that the Lord is good –

Second Reading: Ephesians 5:15-20

This passage is in the nature of a review. The apostle is describing how to walk as simply a figure, a symbol, for how to live. This passage began in Chapter 4, verse 17, with the apostles admonition to live no longer as the Gentiles do – that Christians live as they have been taught to live in Christ.

**Gospel: John 6:51-58** 

Jueus' 'I am' statement that he is the living bread come down from heaven causes much consternation and discussion among those present. And no wonder, for this must have sounded so strange, so foreign to those who heard. Jesus does not soften the blow. Rather he focuses on the rewards that are to be gained. 'Anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life.' To receive the body and blood of Christ is to become fully in communion with the Father. It is truly life-giving.
