## *Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time* *20<sup>th</sup> September 2015 Year B Psalter 1*

### First Reading: Wisdom 2:12,17-20

The wisdom literature has many valuable nuggets to inspire us. The extract for today gives very good insights into evil in the face of good and the efforts engaged in to undermine good. The word godless I feel summarises the activities of the evil ones towards the good godly person. Who could have the ambition to be godless?

### Responsorial Psalm 53

*The Lord upholds my life -*

### Second Reading: James 3:16-4:3

James reveals that what goes on inside the human mind and heart is key to much. Jesus with his statement "out of a man's heart comes all kinds of evil" surely inspired James in this. Paying properly will give the wisdom to live in God's way and to face veil.

### Gospel: Mark 9:30-37

The disciples do not know Jesus fully yet and are slightly edgy about him. They cannot accept that he is to die. They have that inner political and secular notion of his purpose, which he is at pains, in the gospel extracts from recent weeks, to upscuttle. Then, they begin to have political ambitions and let the cat out of the bag by arguing within earshot. Jesus commends childlikeness as a proper response to God and all God wants of them.
