Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time *18th October 2015 Year B Psalter 1*

First Reading: Isaiah 53:10-11

The Servant of the Lord takes on himself the sins of the people and offers his life in atonement for them. His death and subsequent glorification is a source of blessing for others. Reflecting on this the early Church came to understand the meaning of the suffering and death of Jesus. Jesus is the Suffering Servant par excellence.

May your love be upon us O Lord, as we place all our hope in you –

Second Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16

In Jesus, we have a High Priest who was tempted in every way like we are, but without sin. He knows the human condition since he has experienced it himself. Having entered heaven, he is in a position to help us in our trials and sufferings. This is why we can approach him with confidence in times of need.

Gospel: Mark 10:35-45

The apostles are still far from the spirit of self-sacrifice that should characterize the followers of Jesus. Two of them want top places in his kingdom that they assumed would be modified on worldly kingdoms. They would enjoy honor, power and prestige. Jesus tells them that true Christian greatness consists of serving, not exercising power over others. Jesus himself would set the example for them to follow.
