Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

8th November 2015 Year B Psalter 4

First Reading: 1 Kings 17:10-16

Today we hear about a widow. Widows and children were often seen as the undesirables, who stood for nothing and were seen as worth nothing. God's ways are not always our ways and we see how a widow was chosen to have a special purpose in God's plan or revelation. Elijah reveals that when we accept people for who they are, we get something more in return.

My soul, give praise to the Lord –

Second Reading: Hebrews 9:24-28

Christ the high priest has offered himself on our behalf, and when he comes again he will save those who are waiting for him. The sanctuary is our meeting place with God, where we come weekly and daily to meet God in the Word and in the Holy Mass. Our sanctuary is where we meet God and get a foretaste of what awaits us, if only we can imagine how much greater it will be.

Gospel: Mark 12:38-44

Grandparents, like the widow in the Gospel have so much to teach us about values and life. The widow in our Gospel was a woman of faith, a woman of charity, who gave of what she had, always giving without thinking. Grandparents like the widow share the last of what they have and in doing so receives much in return. They show us that it doesn't matter what others think, it only matters what we can share from the heart that makes the difference.
