Third Sunday in Ordinary Time 24th January 2016 Year C Psalter 3

First Reading: Nehemiah 8:2-6, 8-10

A timely affirmation of the power of God's word to move minds and hearts. While Ezra speaks, hungry hearts are touched by God's merciful outreach. Note too Ezra's concluding admonition: "Do not be sad: the joy of the Lord is your stronghold". Not only are we to seek true happiness but God desires that his joy pervade our participation in the fulfilment of his will.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:12-30

Ever doubted your call to be an evangelist, catechist or missionary? Ever found yourself saying "that's the priests job or "that's their parents responsibility". Well, perhaps there is more to it! Here St Paul reminds us that we are all integral to the team, all blessed in a way, and unless we pull together something is likely to go amiss.
