Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord ***20th March 2016 Year C Psalter 2***

First Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7

Saint Paul turns poet in this reading. It is thought that he was reciting an already well-versed prayer. Emptying the self; obedience to god's ways, will and word; humility and a spirit of service; these are the hallmarks of him whose name we bear as a Christian people.

Gospel: Luke 22:14-23:56

Palm Sunday opens out into a week that is the highpoint of the Church Year and a template for the life of every Christian. The events of Holy Week are the events of any of our lives – in miniature. The past is present; re-presented in the stories of Holy Week.
