Fourth Sunday of Easter 17th April 2016 Year C Psalter 4

First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 13:14,43-52

The Church is expanding rapidly, Paul and Barnabas have headed off to bring the Gospel to ex-pat Jewish communities all over the Middle East. Their initial reception was enthusiastic but some established traditional religious Jews not only disowned them but quickly ran them out of town.

Responsorial Psalm: 99
We are his people, the sheep of his flock --

Second Reading: Apocalypse 7:9,14-17

A central feature of the Apocalypse is the struggle between the forces of good and evil. The struggle is depicted through a three fold repeated structure. Firstly, there is persecution of the faithful. Secondly, there is defeat of the evil ones. Thirdly there is the triumph of God and his allies.

Gospel: John 10:27-30

John's Gospel, chapter 10 is based on two themes, Jesus as the messianic shepherd and Jesus as the Son of God. The Gospel readings today very vividly highlight the role of Jesus as messianic shepherd, an image originating in the Exodus of the Jews from slavery. This emphasis has influenced the title of Good Shepherd Sunday.
