First Reading: Jeremiah 38:4-6, 8-10

Jeremiah had prophesied that the Babylonian army would overrun Jerusalem and that all those remaining in the city would be slaughtered while those who left would save themselves. While his words had a disheartening effect he could in no way be accused of nor having 'the welfare of this people at heart'.

Second Reading: Hebrews 12:1-4

The author draws his images from the world of athletics. We are running a race, the finishing line is Jesus, the stadium full of people who live by faith and are cheering us on. We draw the courage to persist by imitating Jesus.

Gospel: Luke 12:49-53

If Jesus came to bring reconciliation, if his message is one of forgiveness, why has it caused such division in the lives of his followers? Why has the good news not been accepted by all? Jesus warns that acceptance by some and rejection by others will cause conflict.

As yet we have not had any volunteers.

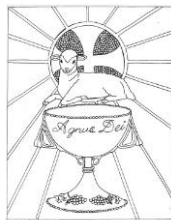
We are now at the middle of August with September rushing towards us. Before the hustle and bustle of
