First Reading: Isaiah 66:18-21

Isaiah calls the people to look forward to a time when Jerusalem will be the glory of the nations. The dispersed children of God will come on pilgrimage to Jerusalem to witness the glory of God. Not only will they find Jerusalem to be their spiritual home, but some of them will be chosen for ministry.

Second Reading: Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13

The author sets out to offer a way of understanding suffering. It can be understood as a form of correction, God allows us to suffer so that we can grow in faith and bear fruit in terms of 'peace and goodness'.

Gospel: Luke 13:22-30

A question provides the launching pad for what follows: 'Will there be only a few saved?' The answer begins with a wisdom saying-'the narrow door' a parable- 'knocking on the door' followed by an apocalyptic description- 'men from east and west...'- 'last will be first' – not how many but who?
