In our first reading today, the prophet Amos remains faithful to his reputation as a fearless champion of the poor and the oppressed. He warns the wealthy of his day against selfishness and greed and warns them of the consequences of their actions.

Paul gives Timothy some sound advice about being a disciple of Jesus in our second reading today. He encourages Timothy to persevere in both his ministry and his personal holiness, even in the face of persecution.
