First Reading: Isaiah 2:1-5

God's presence is felt on high and sometimes in lonely places. Here, the mountain is a place of instruction. Those chosen are set apart and in climbing the mountain will become the people living in right relationship with Yahweh.

Second Reading: 1 Romans 13:11-14

The allusion of light and darkness seems strange at a time when we tend to get up and go to bed in darkness. Perhaps it helps us realise how much light can brighten our lives.
