First Reading Genesis 12:1-4

Second Reading 2 Timothy 1:8-10

Here St Paul is urging Timothy to be ready to undertake hardship for the Gospel. From the outset Christanity faced opposition, challenges, persecution. We are reminded of this when we celebrate the feasts of saints who were martyrs. At present Christians are persecuted in different parts of the world in different ways; persecution, scapegoating even losing the right to be heard in public places.

Gospel Reading Matthew 17:1-9

The story of the Transfiguration is told in all the synoptic Gospels; According to tradition the 'high mountain' is Mount Thabor. Peter, James and John were Christs intimate friends, when Christ took them up the mountainside they expected to spend the night in prayer. The change they witnessed in the person of Christ radiated through his clothes, they were in awe but not shaken.
