# First Reading: Acts 1:1-11

Jesus has completed the task given to Him by His heavenly Father and He returns to the Father. This is the focus of our reflections on the Feast of the Ascension. Christians believe that Jesus was both divine and human – although those who do not believe in God cannot recognise the divinity of Jesus. Consequently, they are unlikely to accept that He has ascenden to heaven at the end of His earthly life.

### Second Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23

Paul prays for the Ephesians that they may have wisdom and knowledge so that they can appreciate more fully the mysteery of the death and resurrection of Christ. It is surely appropriate that we pray for the same wisdom and knowledge so that we can benefit from the death and resurrection of Christ in our lives.

## Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20

Before returning to His Father in heaven. Jesus told his disciples to continue his saving activity. First, they were to make disciples of all nations. Secondly, they were to baptise people in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Thirdly, they were to teach those who were baptised to observe all that Jesus had taught during His earthly ministry.
