The Feast of The Most Holy trinity 11<sup>th</sup> June 2017 Year A Psalter 1

First Reading: Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9

In the aftermath of the golden calf incident, Moses begs the Lord to go with hus people, despite their stubbornness and infidelity, and unable to promise that it won't happen again. In our own lives, it may feel as though we could never ask for God's help in light of our past behaviour. And yet, God delivers the Jewish people to the Promised Land. His forgiveness knows no end.

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 13:11-13

The dissent of the Israelites in the desert is mirrored in the first Christian community of Corrinth. Community life is not easy and requires effort, St Paul urges the them to find common ground, lay their issues to rest and act with Gospel values. A tall order, yet the Lord has set a precedent, He will stay with us wherever our journey takes us.

**Gospel: John 3:16-18** 

This section of the Gospel is so well known. 'For God so loved the world that he gave His only Son'. This is the very basis of Christianity and if we sit quietly with these words the reality begins to infuse in a new way. Our God gave His Son, his very Self, to show us the way to eternal life, to living well, embracing our divinity, to bring us to spiritual fulfilment and understand what our life truly means.
