Day of Continuous Prayer for Marriage & Family Life

First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11

The coming of the Holy Spirit is an abstract concept, yet the account of Pentecost is filled with sensual experience. The disciples, gathered together and in hiding, are enlightened. They hear a sound like a violent wind, feel it fill the house and see tongues of fire descend on each of them. The God who became flesh is encountered in his most ethereal form.

Responsorial Psalm; Psalm 103

Send forth your spirit, O Lord, and renew the face of the earth -

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13

We may often find ourselves identifying those whose beliefs match all, some and none of our own. In this reading, St Paul reminds us of the variety of gifts within the unity of the Spirit, echoing the words of Jesus, 'Whoever is not against us is for us'. There is certainly a wrong way to live, but there is more than one right way.

Gospel: John 20:19-23

The accounts of Jesus after the Resurrection all follow a pattern. The disciples are fearful and feeling alone, Jesus appears, his first words are of peace. The disciples rejoice and Jesus sends them out to proclaim the good news. This pattern is echoed in our experience each time become aware of the Lord, we bring our fears and burdens, we rejoice in him and we seek to share our joy with others.


