Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time 24th September 2017 Year A Psalter 1

First Reading: Isaiah 55:6-9

"Seek the Lord while he is still to be found" Isaiah here issues an urgent call to repentance and a change of heart. That God's ways are above human ways is reflected in the super-human generosity at the heart of today's gospel.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 144The Lord is close to all who call him -

Second Reading: Philippians 1'20-24, 27

According to Acts 16, Philippi was Paul's first missionary foundation in Europe. Even though written from a prison cell with a death sentence in view. Paul's letter to his beloved Philippian community has come to be known as a "letter of joy" In this excerpt from the letter, Paul is wrestling with the possibility of his imminent death. He wants to die, so that he can be united with Christ, but he also wants to live, so that he can proclaim Christ. For him, all that matters is that Christ will be glorified, wether by Paul's death or by his living.

Gospel: Matthew 20:1-16

It has been widely noted that this gospel passage pre-dates the Trade Union movement! Paying everyone the same wage, irrespective of the differential in hours worked, seems quite unfair. For the homilist or catechist who tries to say otherwise, this is a hard sell. It goes against the grain. It turns our sense of justice upside down.
