First Reading: Exodus 22:20-26

Israel has been delivered from slavery, a covenant is being given on Mount Sinai and the journey through the wilderness is over. God wants to set out clearly, through Moses, what he expects od his Chosen People. The reading speaks of what love demands. It is a love that demonstrates justice, fair play, generosity,

kindness and selflessness.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 17

I love you, Lord, my strength -

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10

St Paul and his companions, like Moses, know the demands of the gospel and the opposition believers may face. Paul is complimenting the Thessalonians for their spirit in being imitators of the example given. They respond with joy and so their example became contagious, leading to many converts.

Gospel: Matthew 22: 34-40

Love, not hate, is central to the Christian message. Christian love should be rooted in prayer. Loving God, with all our heart, means giving ourselves totally to him in an intimate relationship through prayer and worship. We cannot then ignore our neighbour if we claim to love God: that would not make sense. Conversely, being a do-gooder without being rooted in prayer and faith rings hollow. It is through word and action that we become fully and totalloy Christian.
