First Sunday of Advent 3rd December 2017 Year B Psalter 1 Day of Continuous Prayer for Families Wednesday 6th December

First Reading: Isaiah 63:16-17, 64:1, 3-8

This reading from Isaiah should be read as a prayer in the vein of the lament psalms. There are acknowledgements of human fault and sinfulness that have left the people 'like withered leaves in the wind' – but there is a greater sense of the mercy of God, who will act dramatically to restore his people, even to the extent of tearing open the heavens.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 79

God of hosts, bring us back; let your face shine on us and we shall be saved -

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1: 3-9

The thanksgiving at the beginning is a set piece of the Pauline letter and normally gives a hint of some of the key issues to be addressed in the letter. Here Paul gives thanks for the graces that have enriched this community, particulalarly in the gift of good teachers and leaders. Yet these very leaders have also been the source of divisions, so Paul changes the perspective from one of narrow focus on giftedness to the need for us all to prepare for the coming of Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 13:33-37

A question that governs the entirity of this chapter: what will be the sign that all is about to be accomplished? (13:4). For believers waiting for a specific sign is a fools game. Christ exhorts his people rather to an attitude of vigilence and reflection, to discover how the Master might be returning to his house in ways missed by a sleeping watchman.

From Bishop Noel Treanor

Since the transfer of Bishop Donal McKeown to Derry and the retirements of Bishop Patrick Walsh and Bishop Anthony Farquhar consideration has been given to the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation within our diocese.

It is now proposed that each year the bishops, on a rotational basis, will celebrate Confirmation in some of the parishes of each Pastoral Community and the Vicars Forane / Pastoral Community Leaders or their Deputies will celebrate the Sacrament in the other parishes.

It is hoped that this plan will allow the bishop(s) to celebrate Confirmation in each of the parishes hosting Confirmation at least once every three years.

St Anne's Confirmation will be on Wednesday 7th March 2018 at 1.30 pm

Important – Please note;
