First Reading Genesis 9:8-15

The destruction of the world by God is consigned to the past. God's covenant with all living things is established. The sign of the covenant is the rainbow set in the sky. This suggests God's regard for the whole cosmos.

Second Reading 1 Peter 3:18-22

Jesus died for the unrighteous, to lead them to God. After his death, he went in spirit to the unrighteous dead to preach new life to them. He had to die to enter the realm of the dead and touch them. In this way his last enemy, death, is conquered. Everything is now subject to God, and with the greatest enemy conquered, the entire cosmos can be left at the Father's feet.

Gospel Reading Mark 1:12-15
