In the name of Jesus the Nazarene, Peter heals the disabled man who used to sit begging at the Beautiful Gate of the Temple. Peter uses the healing to teach the people that it's through Jesus – the one they rejected- that this man now walks.

Followers of Christ are called to love by keeping his commandments and obeying his words. But should they fail, they have Christ (here referred to as our advocate with the Father), the sacrafice that takes our sins away. He didn't die on the cross for you to bear the burden of your sins.
