- 3. The holiness that God calls you to will grow through small gestures
- 4. It is not healthy to love silence while fleeing interaction with others
- 5. Modern technology and consumerism can often leave no room for God's voice
 - 6. Do not be afraid of holiness or of going against the flow 7. Embrace the Beatitudes
 - 8. Do not let the sun go down on your anger
 - 9. Christian joy is usually accompanied by a sense of humour 10. God is eternal newness
