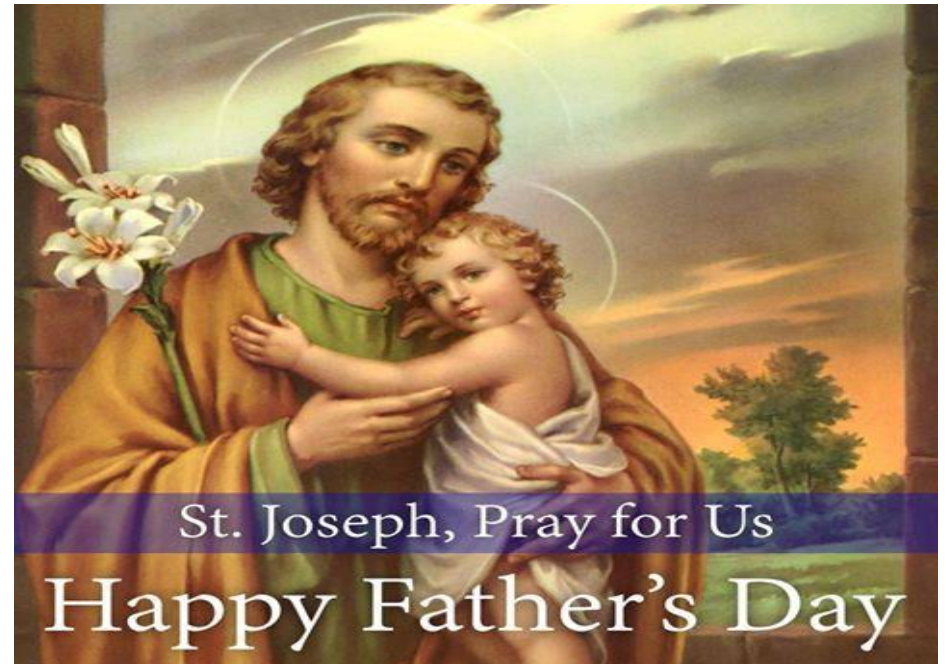

Single day tickets for the Final Mass are free and will be available from the website from 25th June.

You will need a ticket for the Final Mass in Phoenix Park

Your tickets will be sent to you closer to the event

Every adult and child attending will need a ticket. Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. All tickets will be for standing sections

It is not possible to apply for tickets for both Phoenix Park and Knock, as both events will take place on the same day. You may only apply for one of these events

Your tickets will be sent by email in the form of a ‘print at home’ ticket. This will include travel information, with details of how to get to your section of Phoenix Park for the Mass
