1st July 2018 Year B Psalter 1

First Reading: Wisdom 1:13-15, 2:23-24
“Nothing to do with me” is a phrase with which we are all familiar. In this case how true is it of Yahew. Death is an accepted part of life, but from where did it originate? Not with Yahweh! It's not in God's plan for it's not in his nature. Its origin is in the dark heart of the evil one.

Responsorial Psalm: 29
I will praise you Lord, you have rescued me -

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 8:7,9, 13-15
Community life is based on faith and reason, self-regard and respect for others is the simple model St Paul puts before the people of Corinth in his letter. He's offering counsel and instruction to an emerging local Church. The advice to the local Christian community is striking in the moderation of its tone – give as God gave in Christ.

Gospel: Mark 5:21-42
No more pastoral scene do we encounter in the gospels than this one – the sick call, the priestly call to the house at the time of a death, the anguish of a family, the need to comfort, the unrestraint of people in the face of deep loss. And it's a child, among the saddest of visits of all to make.

Single day tickets for the Final Mass are free and will be available from the website from 25th June.

You will need a ticket for the Final Mass in Phoenix Park

Every adult and child attending will need a ticket. Under 18s must be accompanied by an adult. All tickets will be for standing sections
It is not possible to apply for tickets for both Phoenix Park and Knock, as both events will take place on the same day. You may apply for one of these events
Your tickets will be sent by email in the form of a 'print at home' ticket. This will include travel information, with details of how to get to your section of Phoenix Park for the Mass.
