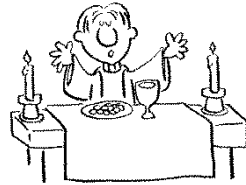

## Gathering Hymn

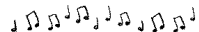

## VACANCY - PART TIME SACRISTAN - ST ANNE'S PARISH

A vacancy has arisen for a Part-time Sacristan within the parish.

The responsibilities will include:

- the maintenance of the sacristy where the church's liturgical items are kept including vestments, sacred vessels and books etc.
  - ensuring that the sanctuary is set up for mass, other services, baptisms and funerals and that all the requisite books and sacramental vessels etc. are in place
  - ensuring the sanctuary is cleared after all services and the church is left secure and tidy.
