

This topic has been on the agenda of the Diocese for some time, and arrangements have been made to offer advice and guidance to parishes to help them overcome some of the difficulties they may encounter if they do not have compliant processes in place.

A presentation covering Copyright and Music Licensing will be held at **St Brigid's Hall, Belfast on 15th February** from 7.30pm until 9pm. Tea/coffee will be served from 7pm.

The presentations will be particularly relevant to choir directors, choir members, cantors, psalmists, parish musicians and parish contemporary music groups. Those who are responsible for setting up or maintaining parish websites are especially welcome.
